What's been happening

- Joint working parties of local authorities, Transit, ONTRACK and Utilities working to revise and update existing Code of Practice for Working in the Road by providing the technical inputs
- Directors Group responsible for overall strategic direction of the “code”
- Collaboration is essential to achieve best overall outcomes for all parties

Current Situation

- Outline draft document now compiled
- Working groups still in action to produce final drafts
- Directors Group has the unenviable task of pulling it together and filling the gaps
- MED still looking for National Code by October 2007
- Industry workshops to follow in November as interactive discussion sessions

RCA Forum Involvement

- All RCAs /TLAs will be affected and need to keep themselves informed and involved
- Looking for feedback – will be sent to targeted local government people for first comment
- Wider consultation on more complete document later
- Quick responses essential – silence is acquiescence
- Support groups of TLA and TNZ may be beneficial
