Review of regional plans etc

- Reviewed all except Auckland
- 11 RPS, 11 RLTS, 5 other policies/plans
- 8 regions had both RPS and RLTS
- Only 3 the same for RPS and RLTS
- Specific reference to road run-off in 7 RPS, and 5 RLTS
- 10 of the 15 surveyed referenced road run-off in either RPS or RLTS

Greater Wellington Stormwater Action Plan

- Framework for SW management
- Developed consultatively and concurrently with RPS
- “live” document
- Three main outcomes:
 - Issues and Options report
 - SW Action Plan
 - Greater understanding and networking

GW Plan for 2007/2008

- Regulation – regionally consistent framework for consents
- Investigation – compiling information
- Operation – industry risk profile, LIUDD
- Education – both sector and public
- Delegation trial – to Hutt City, enforcement of environmental standards
